Merchant Marine Candidates Urged To Apply Now

Birmingham-Bloomfield youth interested in becoming cadets in the U. S. merchant marine academy are urged to contact Captain William S. Broomfield (R-Oakland county). The academy at Kings Point Long Island, offers a four-year course leading to a license as an officer in the U. S. merchant marine, a commission as ensign in the U. S. naval reserve and a bachelor science degree. The sophomore year is spent as a cadet on ships of the U. S. merchant marine. Tuition, room and board, required uniform and textbooks as well as medical and dental care are furnished by the federal government.

A CANDIDATE must be single, in excellent health, must have reached his 17th but not his 22nd birthday by July 1, 1960, be a high school graduate or now in his senior year. Broomfield will appoint 10 candidates to the merchant marine academy. These candidates then will compete for entrance to the academy in nationwide tests to be given in March, 1960. Entrance to the academy will be in August, 1960. Those interested may write Congressman Broomfield at Room 1000, New House Office Building, Washington 25, D. C.
