Henry's to Construct Drive-In

Plans to erect a minimum of 32 self-service drive-in restaurants in the Detroit area with anticipated annual retail sales of nearly five million dollars, have been announced jointly by Charles Robbins, president of Henry's Drive-In, Inc., Chicago, and M. D. Harwell of Detroit. Harwell's franchise covers Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties. Among the locations under

consideration is Birmingham. A typical Henry's Drive-In grosses between \$200,000 and \$400,000 annually, with a net profit of from \$25,000 to \$35,000 to the operator. Choice of locations is based on available land in heavy traffic areas, and units can be built by property owners for investment purposes on a long-range basis.
