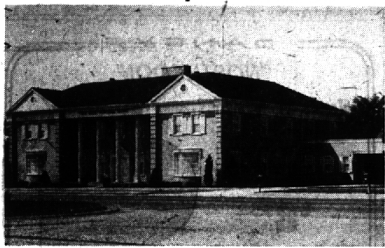


Senior Scouts Off to Colorado

E. P. Sammut's Home from Trip

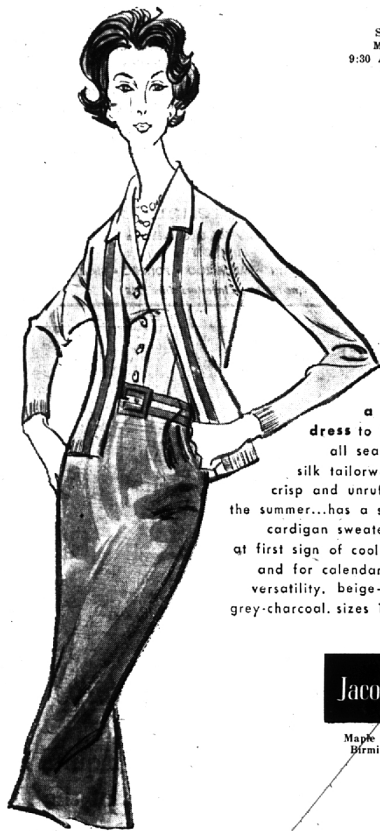

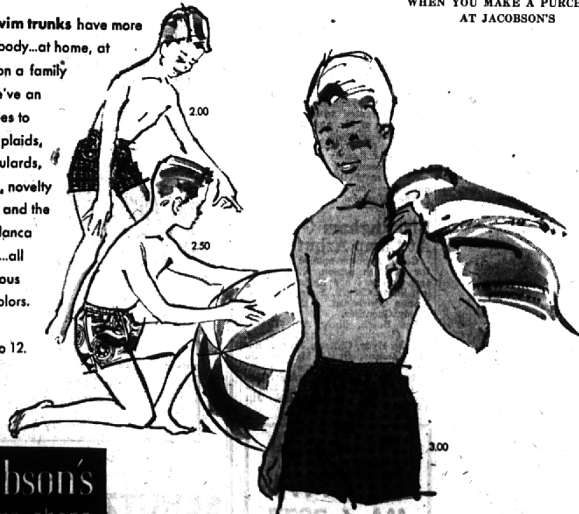
