

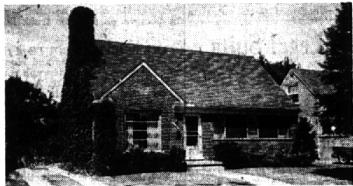

Southfield News Briefs

Expressway May Cut Civic Center

SOUTHFIELD — City officials are waiting to see if the proposed east-west expressway will cut through land on Evergreen between 10 and 11 Mile roads, earmarked for the new civic center.

Although Highway Commissioner John C. Mackie has said that the route is flexible he has declared a right-of-way from Northwestern and Telegraph west to Grand River and Haggerty. This could cut through the proposed civic center.

Southfield B of E To Fill Vacancy

SOUTHFIELD—Gleann W. Levey said Monday that he expected the Southfield school board to appoint a seventh member July 6 at an organizational meeting.

The board has until July 13 to fill the vacancy left by the resignation of Phillip A. Moloney. Although several names have been suggested, Levey said final decision will rest on the decision of the present board members.

Industrial Design Center Construction Starts in Southfield

SOUTHFIELD — Ground was broken last week at 10 1/2 Mile road and Telegraph by Sandberg-Pearl Inc. for an industrial-design center, termed the world's largest.

More than 100 designers and expert model builders will be housed in the two-story, steel glass and concrete ultra-modern building.

Total cost of the project, which will include a guest house for out-of-town clients, will be approximately \$200,000. Completion is scheduled Jan. 15 next year.
