A \$26,861.50 refund Birmingham has just received from Oakland county is being saved for repayment to the county in the next several years.

City Treasurer James Parkins said the check totals the amount of money Birmingham has advanced to the county drain commissioner since Dec. 7, 1954, for use in setting up the Evergreen sewage disposal system.

Now that the county DPW has taken over the project, now under construction, the advances are being returned from proceeds of the bond issue which is financing the Evergreen.

BIRMINGHAM, and five other municipalities, now have to pay off the county bonds.

That's where Birmingham's \$26,861.50—and several hundred thousand other dollars—will be used in the next 20 or 30 years.
