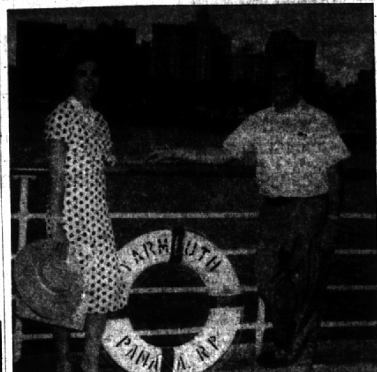

### John O'Flynn's Receive Top Trophy

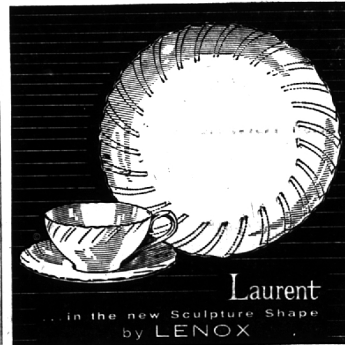

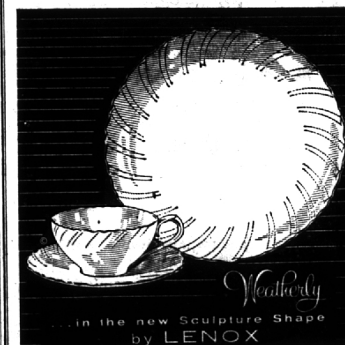
