Lassies - Lads Tee Off at CC

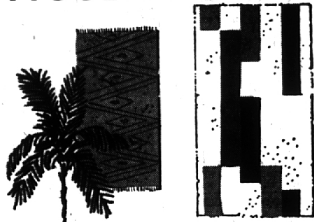
