DOWN TO EARTH
Church Parking Lots
Show Good Planning

Space use and planning is very important, whether you are planning home grounds, the area around a factory, or a retail store where you wish to attract a following. Landscaping church property has been a pet interest of mine.

If you plan to be home this summer where you can follow up a regular watering program, you can plan to add roses to any location all summer due to their method of retail potting, as well as other plants which are burlap and balled. I generally water new transplants with Transplantone to assure a minimum shock resulting from tearing away the secondary roots.

KEEPING UP with the new ideas, many gardeners are applying their fertilizers in a liquid form. By the use of a radioactive tracer it has been found that fertilizer given in a liquid form will be found in all parts of a plant within two hours.

When fertilizer is given to a plant in a powdered form at the base of the plant, the fertilizer will not benefit the plant until it has been diluted by water. If you sprinkle fertilizer at the base of a plant and then work it into the soil by a hoe you are apt to disturb and cut the roots, which is harmful.

Less fertilizer is required when the fertilizer is diluted with water than when it is applied in a dry form. Read the directions carefully for your variety of fertilizer.
