The school, which now numbers 47 girls needs more room and plans to find it at Square Lake and Squirrel roads, Bloomfield township.

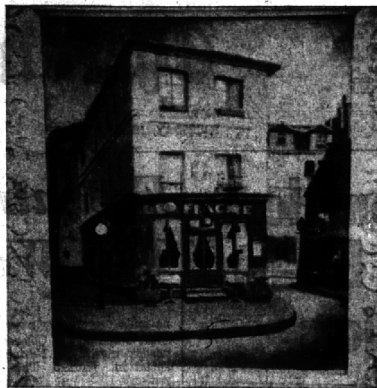
Plans for a modern school building with eight classrooms and a multi-purpose room have been approved. The twelve-acre site has a lake for supervised swimming and boating.
