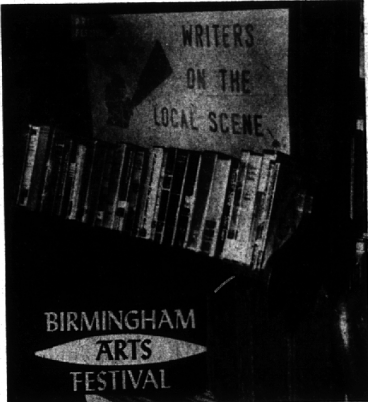

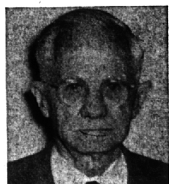
Local Writers Featured

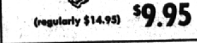

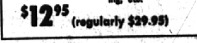
