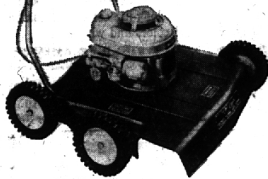

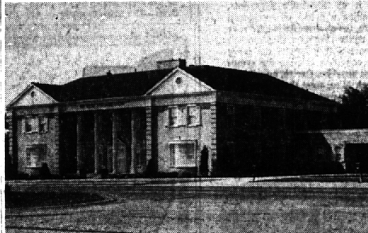
PURPOSE OF the annual service, as expressed by the clergy and the vestry of the churches, is to symbolize their unity of purpose and common task.

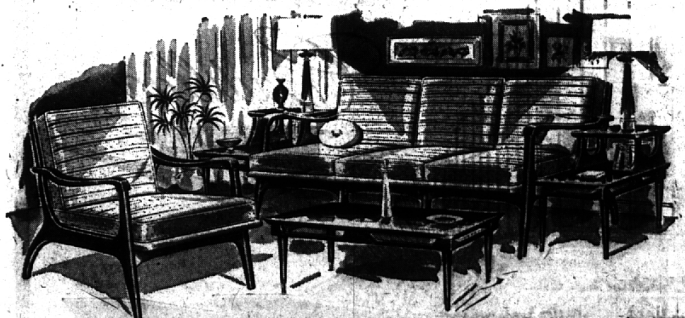
