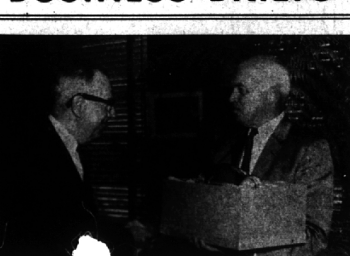

It is 500 pounds heavier than the average import, giving it superior roadability and stability.
