**Oil Poured on Troubled Road**  
BEVERLY HILLS—The telephone has stopped its constant ringing at the Walter Kouba residence. Last Thursday and Friday Pierce street was graded, re-graveled, graded again, and then oiled. "I was getting eight and ten phone calls per day from Pierce street residents complaining about the dust there despite calcium chloriding," Beverly Hills Road Commissioner Walter Kouba said Tuesday.

"With the fine cooperation of the residents who contributed their money," Kouba continued, "we were able to apply the oil."

Since the oiling, allowed only on Pierce, which cost property owners the same 6 cents per running foot charged for calcium chloriding, Kouba said he had received several "always welcome" complimentary calls.

He said the village was working out an agreement with contractors Fulle & Strong, builders of the junior-senior high school, who had agreed to assume "their share" of maintenance work on the portion of Evergreen road which their heavy trucks are using.
