Outdoor Greek Theatre Scene of Eccentrics

St. Dunstan's Guild will present for six performances a completely original musical comedy, "The Birmingham Eccentrics." Most ambitious project in St. Dunstan's 25-year history, the play deals good naturedly with the fun and foibles of the lives of the people in the Birmingham-Bloomfield area.

The show is not a collection of individual skits, but rather is a full scale musical comedy in the best Broadway tradition. The entire story, music and lyrics have been created by St. Dunstan's members.

THE STORY DEALS with the sensation created in the "Birmingham" community when, after 40 years, the owner of the local newspaper, the Birmingham Bugle, sells out to a newcomer who turns the town upside down by reporting the goings on around town with an unsympathetic and critical eye. The effect on the community is startling.

The play includes 16 original songs that deal with a wide range of subjects all dear to the hearts of Birmingham area people. There are a two piano accompaniment played by Janet Martin and Bob Bates.

The musical comedy is based on an idea of Walker Graham's. It is being directed by Dean Coffin with Mrs. Otis Thompson and Mrs. Fred Hendricks, Jr., as assistant directors, and Mrs. Albert Remington as executive producer assisted by Mrs. Roy Nelson and Mrs. Stephen Manhard.
