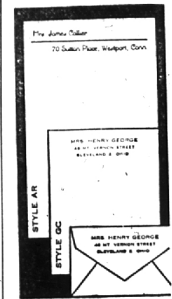


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## Housewives Didn't Make Alaska Trip

plain his cocky self-confidence in recent months. "America's situation is not hopeless," Alsop continued, "but we must have a more serious conventional force to counter-balance the Russian and Chinese divisions, and a more serious participation in the missile race."

We must have just plain "guts," Alsop says, so that Khrushchev can never attempt to destroy this country without the assurance that he will be destroyed, too.

LAST OF all, we must be willing to fight a war in full consciousness of the terrible consequences. "We must be willing to die, in order to live," he said.

"If we have the guts to stay the course, there is still hope in our lifetimes for peace and prosperity." Later, at a luncheon at Birmingham country club, Alsop said, "If you are willing to fight against the tyranny of Communism, write your Senators, representatives, and also the White House. Let them know that you are willing to make sacrifices to remain free men and women."

Most recently he has been representing Ford of U. S. in its relationships with Ford of Canada and advising on that corporation's domestic and overseas operations.

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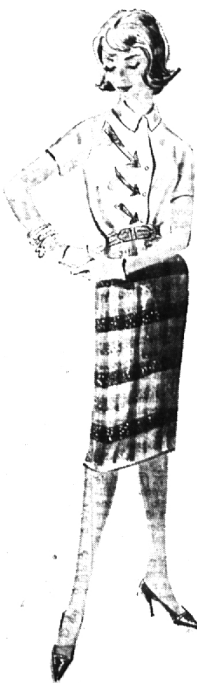
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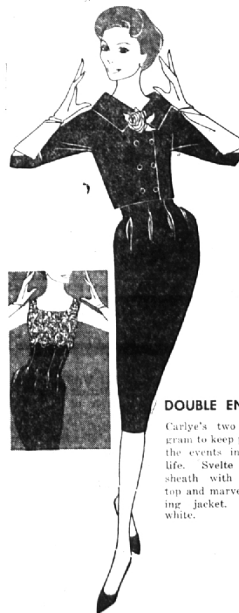
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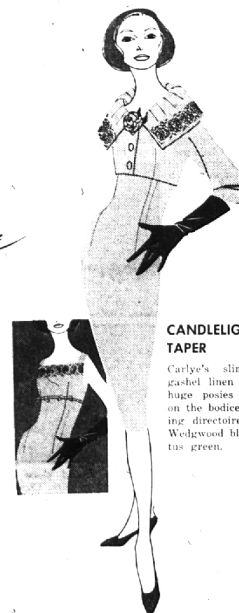
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
