Registration for the spring Saturday swim class began on March 14. The spring swim class begins on April 4 and continues through June 13. The cost is \$3 per person. The class does not meet on May 30, Memorial day.

All boys who are members of the Y.M.C.A., eight years of age and older as of April 1, and 48 inches tall are eligible to enroll. The fee is waived for any boy's dad willing to teach during the spring term. The maximum enrollment is determined by the weekly attendance, which shall not exceed 45 boys.

Parents are asked to make an effort to enroll their boys by April 1. During the winter class too many boys signed up three and four weeks after the swim class began.

The boys are transported to the Pontiac Y.M.C.A. by bus. The bus leaves the "Y" building, 400 E. Lincoln, at 12:15 p.m. Parents should pick their children up at 3 p.m. as the building is closed.

This is a swim instruction class. The boys are in the pool from 1 to 2 p.m.

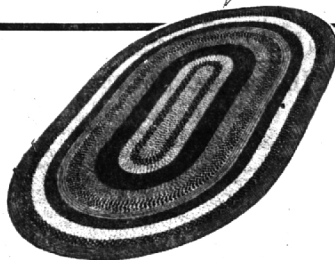

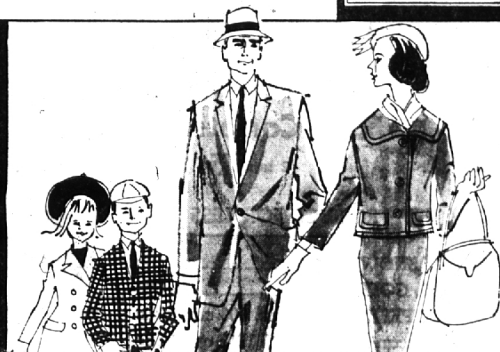
