## BUSINESS BRIEFS

### Approve Transfer Of Liquor License At Fox and Hounds

BLOOMFIELD HILLS — The way was paved for the sale of the Fox and Hounds Inn Tuesday night when the Bloomfield Hills city commission approved the transfer of the liquor license.

Approval of the transfer was sought by Clements and Ford, incorporated, prospective buyers of the restaurant landmark at Woodward and Long Lake roads.

THE FOX and Hounds Inn has been part of the Bloomfield Hills area since 1927 when it was first opened by Manley Davis.

It was later purchased by the current owner, John Ingleson.

There have been two large fires at the Inn since it was opened. Extensive damage was incurred by a fire in 1943 and more than \$25,000 worth of damages was caused by a blaze in 1951.

### Construction On Rise in B'ham

Construction in Birmingham rose last month compared to February of last year, according to Building Inspector Andrew F. Butt.

Eleven building permits for construction valued at \$114,500 were issued in February as compared to \$84,050 issued in 1958.

CONSTRUCTION for the first two months of 1958 was still ahead of this year's figure by a large margin. A total of \$197,700 worth of construction has been started in January and February as compared to \$528,050 last year.

All of the construction started last month was on new homes.
