CONFUSED!

Well, we're not—not too much, at least to point out a few things that will help you to a successful lawn, shrub, flower and tree yard this summer.

Let us forget the weather reports as they seldom correspond with our mood when we are trying to help you. Some generalities may be more helpful with the "guide points" we mention.

LAWN FERTILIZER

If you are a "fortunate" from whose yard the ice has departed, you may, and should:—

SPREAD 2 lbs. of AGRICO U.F., AGRICO for TURF, STADLER'S XXX or WOOD-RUFF'S GRO-SOD on each 100 sq. ft. of turf. When done it is a job done and can be forgotten for 3 months. If you don't do it now it will conflict with early worm golf, early picnic children, etc.

THE SPREADER:—

In spite of the thousands of ads regarding spreaders, we feel that you should drop in to see all the features and advantages that can be yours by being analytical and paying a bit more to acquire a

LAWN BEAUTY SPREADER

It is easy to move, accurate as to rate of distribution and, because of its cleaning arrangement, it can be a piece of equipment you will have for 6 or 8 years (instead of 2 or 3 like the average spreader).

There is a small table in our shop and on it are some chemicals which are shoddy indeed—but worth 2 to 3 times their present cost. Everything on the table is 50% off the retail and the retail is the same as 3 or 4 years ago on most things. Are you alert? Here is a bargain.

We are writing this Sunday evening and on looking out the window decided to mention:—

1. Snow shovel
2. Salt for the ice
3. Ice Melting Chemicals

The PERMANEST PLANT TRAYS and additional stands, lights, timing clocks, Vermiculite, potting soil, seeds, tubers, etc., will give you a big head start on that untidy neighbor if you get going right away. The seedlings can be better than those you buy at a shop later on.

We have two lousy spreaders for sale. They are not, however, so lousy they won't bring a price. When they are sold we will be happy and so will the buyer.

All the gray spots in your lawn near melting snow banks and ice piles should be sprayed right away with TERSAN.

This 50-mile gale tonight might do some pruning for you, but we still believe your stuff will benefit by a bit of intelligent help from you—if you are reading this.

DORMANT SPRAY—Put it on all shrubs and trees when the temperature will remain above 40 degrees for 12 hours.

Curley Tables His Motion


The other night at the Ricer, Curley was shaking his head over "young people," his daughter in particular.
