Amos Battenfield, 41, former plant superintendent for The Birmingham Eccentric the past 13 years, has resigned this week to assume ownership of the Rittman Press in Rittman, Ohio.

He will be replaced by Richard A. Ruck, 40, of Wyandotte, former superintendent of The Trenton Times.

Battenfield will assume operation of the Rittman-Press next Monday. Married, with two children, he received his bachelor of arts degree in journalism from the University

of Oklahoma. He taught journalism and printing at Arkansas State college before joining the army for service during World War II. He saw action in the Pacific theater and was discharged with the rank of captain.

## B'field Boy's Club To Sell Orchids Here Saturday

Members of the West Bloomfield Boys club will be selling orchids on Birmingham streets Saturday. The group was given permission to hold the sale here by city commissioners Monday night. Two of the commissioners were strongly against granting the club permission to sell here, but they were outvoted.

Mayor Carl F. Ingraham and Commissioner William F. Roberts both pointed out that it has been the city's policy to discourage the number of sales which private organizations hold.

DONALD J. ARNOT, manager of the boys' club and Vernon Edward, mayor of Keego Harbor appeared at the meeting to ask permission for the sale.

Proceeds from the sale will be used for a new club building. The commission also granted local veterans' organization permission to hold their annual poppy sale Thursday, May 21, or Friday, May 22, in case of rain on Thursday.
