Troy News Briefs

Rezone More "Strip" Land

For the second time in three weeks, Troy city commissioners ignored their plan consultant's advice and rezoned a second parcel of property for "strip business," Monday night.

By a 5-2 vote, the commission

rezoned land owned by Earl E. Klusendorf for business. The land is on both sides of Rochester road south of 17 Mile.

ON MARCH 9, a tract of land owned by George S. Forsyth was rezoned for business over the objections of nearby homeowners and city plan consultant George Villan.

The East Central Troy Improvement association has already filed suit in Circuit Court and has obtained a temporary restraining order to keep the Forsyth property residential.

Circuit Judge H. Russell Holland set the show cause hearing for April 13.

Court Order Halts Plans on Expressway

The Troy Meadows Home Owners' association received a temporary restraining order from Circuit Court Judge H. Russell Holland ordering the City of Troy and the State highway commission to stop plans for the proposed Chrysler Expressway route.

Three Troy city Commissioners, Roy L. Duncan, Louis Yanich and Clifford Sutermeister Jr., were accused of voting for the proposed route because they own property on the route.

THE ASSOCIATION filed suit charging the commissioners would benefit from the sale of property they own.


The city of Troy and State Highway Commissioner John C. Mackie have been ordered to appear April 13 to show cause why a permanent injunction should not be granted.
