THE STORM STRUCK no closer than west Bloomfield township, where it uprooted trees, toppled chimneys, scattered shingles, downed a garage and made off with porches.

"FORTY THOUSAND YEARS ago there towered over Oakland County a blanket of ice as thick as a mile thick. It is our heritage that the little community of Morris Mill, where grain was ground, and mashes were brewed, and the acres where Samuel Alexander developed himself a poor farmer, have been transformed into a new community where young women and young men, and who are older, are given a fresh impetus to lead dedicated, less selfish lives."
