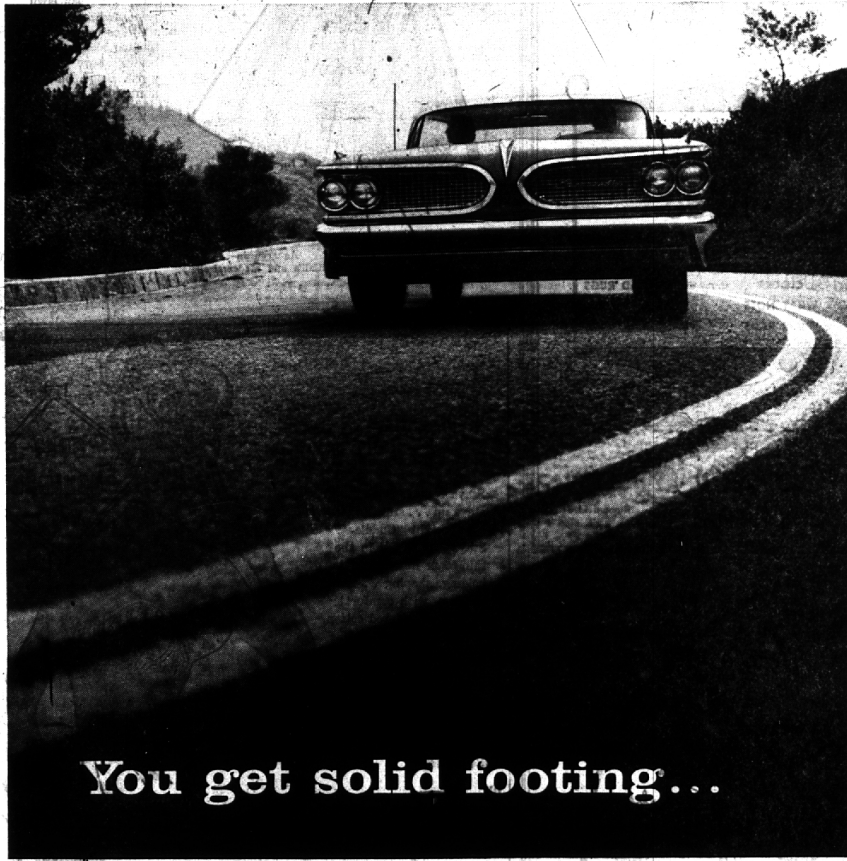

Paddles Canoe 218 Miles

A Birmingham man was one of 16 Dartmouth College students who recently paddled canoes 218 miles down the Connecticut River from Hanover to Long Island Sound. He is Robert Harvey, son of Mr. and Mrs. R. M. Harvey of Graceland road, Birmingham.

The canoeist followed a trail blazed by John Ledyard, class of 1795, who used this method of transportation to leave Hanover in 1793. Ledyard subsequently became a world traveler of considerable repute, and now is honored as one of Dartmouth's most illustrious alumni.

IN NAVIGATING the course, Harvey and his partner set a new record in covering the distance in 46 hours and 20 minutes, 7 hours and 40 minutes faster than the best previous time.

A sophomore at Dartmouth, Harvey is a geography major and a member of the Dartmouth Outing club. He was graduated from Whitehaven high school in Tennessee.
