Insurance policies covering the township hall, contents and valuable papers were let to the Freetz insurance agency.

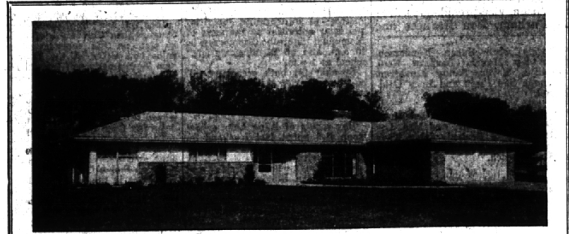

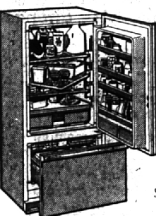

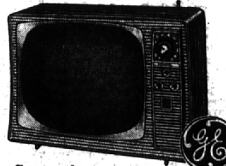
