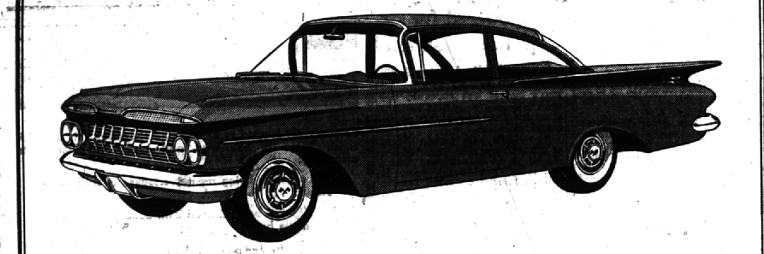
Mrs. Joseph LaPlant of Meadowlake road recently entertained members of the Meadowlake bridge club.

Handicraft Booth Highlights June 6 Walnut Lake Fair

Notice of redemption shall be published not less than 30 days prior to the date fixed for redemption, at least once in a newspaper or publication circulated in the City of Detroit, Michigan, which carries as a part of its regular service, notices of the sale of municipal bonds and interest will be payable at such bank and/or trust company as shall be designated by the original purchaser of the bonds. Such purchaser shall have the right to name a co-purchaser.

For the purpose of awarding the bonds, the interest cost of each bid will be computed by determining, at the rate or rates specified therein, the total dollar value of all interest on the bonds of Oakland County and the City of Detroit, Michigan, and deducting therefrom any premium. The bonds will be awarded to the bidder whose bid on the above computation produces the lowest interest cost of the bonds or at a price less than their par value, will be considered.

A certified or cashier's check in the amount of \$138,000 drawn on an incorporated bank or trust company and payable to the order of the Treasurer of the County of Oakland must accompany each bid as a guarantee of good faith on the part of the bidder. The cost of said legal opinion and of the printing of the bonds will be borne by the county. There will also be furnished the usual closing papers, including a non-litigation certificate, dated as of the date of the delivery of the bonds. Bonds will be delivered at New York, N. Y., or Chicago, Ill., at the option of the purchaser.
