

Bingham Woman Reports on Multiple Sclerosis Weeks

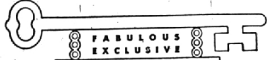

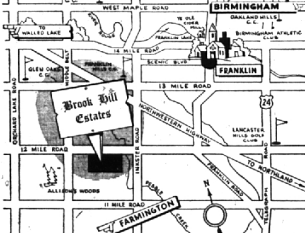

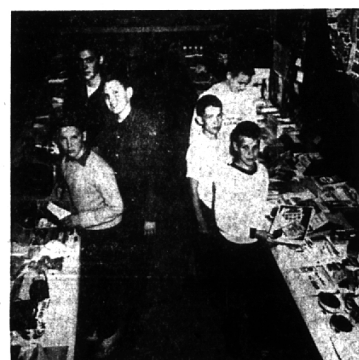

Cranbrook Residents Give Views on Stream Control

CRANBROOK VILLAGE — Residents of Cranbrook Village were given an opportunity last week to express their views on the future of the small stream that runs through the heart of their subdivision. According to Willie Henry, chairman of the stream committee, 80 out of 100 homes represented favored an automatically controlled bascule gate. Two voters favored a plan proposed by the county drain commissioner, five indicated a number of small steps in the plan of dams as their first choice, and four preferred to have the entire drain put underground.

THE DRAIN commissioner's plan, said Henry at a meeting held last week at Northbrook school, was for a 25-foot wide ditch approximately six feet deep through the village. The present stream has dam and waterfalls, Henry continued, with a certain natural beauty. Homes costing \$18,000 to \$35,000, he said, would appreciate greatly if the project was constructed as proposed by the county.

HENRY TOLD THE 125 assembled residents that an underground installation for the subdrainage area would cost about \$100,000. The bascule gate and revised dam

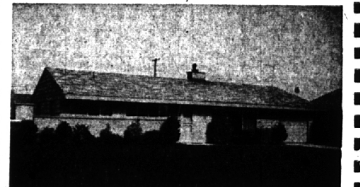
