

You have warmed our hearts with your letters, cards, jokes, calls, flowers, prayers, presents, phone calls, and especially the loving care of our daughter at home. We have always known that our relatives and friends were the most but now Chatham county of Georgia knows it, too! As soon as we can find some money, we are going to buy telephone stock—believe me, Michigan Bell never had it so good! Our northern friends use the phone like an inter-com!

"JUST PICTURE the four of us (Ginni happily safe on her Senior Class Washington trip) breezing along in the T-bind—calm—peaceful—no worries.
