However, commissioners Monday night felt compelled to vent THEIR feelings, to give their impressions of how the situation has developed. They probably hope they don't have to go through this again Monday night. That's when Lincoln widening is up for confirmation of the special assessment roll.

AT THE NECESSITY hearing April 27, spokesmen asked if the commission would consider alternatives. The answer was "Yes, we will consider alternatives if they also consider future traffic volumes."

One of the Lincoln-Pierce-Southfield spokesmen and leaders against the 41-foot widening is Dean Perry, 508 W. Lincoln.

He appeared Monday night to present the subdivision group's proposal: They desire the improvement to be held to 30 feet from the standard for a residential street.

City commissioners began a long discussion about various aspects of the widening.

COMMISSIONERS listened to Perry for a while.

It was puzzling to some on the sidelines why the commission was letting the discussion go on and on. The regular business had been finished in about an hour. No another 30 minutes had gone by in a rebuff of the Lincoln problem.

It was a comment from Perry that brought forth the real feelings of the commission—diplomatically spoken, of course.

Perry said, "There has been considerable emotion worked up in this problem, but I hope you commissioners will forgive that."

It was Commissioner Florence Willett who took first aim.

SHE SAID: "Mr. Perry, we can forgive the emotion, but we can't forgive the attacks that have been made on the integrity and character of the city officials."

Commissioner Carl P. Ingraham seconded Mrs. Willett's comment. Then he added:

"It seems that those who are coming up here over this project have the feeling we commissioners are out to do your group harm. Those kinds of groups usually find we have a deal for you. We don't think we are prejudiced or biased. We have the interests at heart of the entire city, including the groups and the individuals."

PERRY APOLOGIZED for the Lincoln group.

"If that is the case," he emphasized the emotion worked up in this problem, but I hope you commissioners will forgive that. We know you will do the best for the city."

Commissioner Charles Renfrew spoke.

He said: "I feel as do the others. We cannot discharge our responsibility by letting groups have their way unnecessarily. Since 1951 when I came on the council, many projects have been done. We have yet to find one of them which we have not benefited from. It is time and been a good improvement."

I HOPE you and your group feel our action is in the best judgment, whether you feel the city is shortsighted or too free. Because it does represent lots of previous experience."

Commissioner William Burghum went after Perry. He said the group called "those general thinking to use such terms as trunkline highways, massive traffic diversion, removal of boulevard sections."

"These are not facts," Burghum emphasized, "although I agree you can strike up great interest by using such terms."

PERRY AGAIN defended himself and his group.

Renfrew and Ingraham attempted to pin Perry down on his facts. Perry talked in pretty general terms.
