During the past four years, the

Conservatory has been located at 424 Pierce, where it had grown steadily to its present size of enrollment.

This past year the music school launched upon a program of expansion due to the interest shown by Birmingham and neighboring communities in the Conservatory as a cultural and educational institution.

MOVING to larger quarters was necessitated by the addition of several new departments. At present, the Conservatory faculty consists of 12 experienced instructors, all Conservatory and college graduates, several with European background, experienced in symphony orchestras and as solo concert artists.

In addition to its present program of instruction in piano, voice, and all instruments, the Conservatory will add, at its new location, classes in ballet, rhythmic dance, instrumental and vocal ensemble, opera workshop and foreign languages, and dramatics.
