## Cars Replace Cows in This '59 Road-E-O

The deadline is fast approaching for receiving applications to the annual Safe Driving Road-E-O sponsored by the Birmingham Junior Chamber of Commerce. This event will be held Saturday, May 16, 10 a.m. at the Ford Tractor plant, 2500 East Maple road, Birmingham.

Entry blanks are available to all eligible teen-agers under 19. They may be secured through driver-training instructors at the following high schools: Birmingham, Bloomfield Hills, Southfield and Troy. Also, at the Birmingham Community House, Lake Jewelers in Birmingham and from other merchants.

Applicants must reside in the area served by the high schools, have a driver's license or permit and have no moving traffic violations in the past six months.

A written examination will be held at the high schools during the week prior to the driving test.

Local winners will compete at Midland this summer. Winners from all 50 states meet in August in Washington, D. C. to try for \$4,500 in scholarships.

## Harabedian Suit Postponed Again

Sometime in June, the city of Birmingham may see its zoning ordinance substantiated—or held unreasonable.

City Attorney Dean G. Beier informed the city this week that it looks like the Oakland circuit court may hear the suit brought by Mike Harabedian and several other S. Maple property owners.

Plaintiffs in August 1954 brought suit charging the city's residential zoning on Maple at Coolidge was unreasonable. It should be commercial, the suit charged.

An injunction also was sought prohibiting the city from selling same block as a controversial property. The city wants to sell the lot for residential use.

This week the injunction was dissolved as a condition to the plaintiffs' request to postpone the case from an April 28 trial date.

## DPW Amendment OK'd, Evergreen Is On Way

Though it is hopelessly mired in its attempt at state financial relief, the Michigan legislature came through in less than three weeks with an act to permit the Evergreen inter-ceptor's start by June 1.

Meanwhile the delay in the project, scheduled to start the end of April until a Supreme Court decision forced cancellation of a bond sale, has cost \$250,000.

Last Friday the Michigan water resources commission voted to give the money to other projects. The quarter million aid to the north portion of the Evergreen was a federal grant.

THE COUNTY will reapply for a federal grant if the government assistance program continues next year.

Tuesday the Michigan House of Representatives passed the amendment to the Oakland county DPW act which makes possible the sale of bonds for the big \$7 million project.

Oakland county DPW director Harold K. Schone said the bill was expected to be on the governor's desk for signature Wednesday or Thursday.

The amendment will become effective immediately, since more than a two-thirds majority approved it. The house approved the

validates the contracts between the county and participating townships.

IT CLARIFIED the DPW act with regard to the township's 15 mill limitations. Introduced April 15 by State Senator Harvey F. Lodge, the bill incorporates wording into the DPW act which states that nothing in the township's agreements should be construed as an evasion of the 15-mill limitation.

The Supreme Court had refused April 13 to rehear a split decision suit testing the legality of the DPW law. The bond sale was cancelled immediately and the act introduced into the legislature.
