Openings Left At Cranbrook

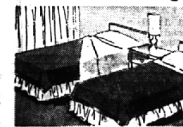
A limited number of new applications will be taken for Cranbrook's 19th summer theater school session, it was announced this week.

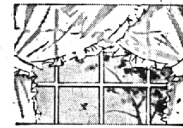

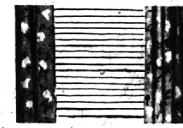
