

## Local Men Aid Sponsorship Of Croatian Pianist Kunc

Now that he has chosen Detroit as his home, his Croatian friends (including many in the Birmingham area) are sponsoring a well-known European composer's first piano recital here Friday.

Bozidar Kunc will be presented by the Croatian board of trade in Detroit. The performance is scheduled for 8:30 p.m. Friday in the small auditorium of the Detroit Institute of Arts.

Kunc is the sister of the famous Metropolitan opera star Zinka Milanov. He coached his sister from the beginning of her vocal training until today, except for the war years 1939-47 when he lived in Yugoslavia and she in America.

KUNC came to America from his Yugoslavian homeland in 1951. Since that time he has been his sister's accompanist on concert tours. Other artists he has accompanied are Set Svahnholm and Erna Berger.

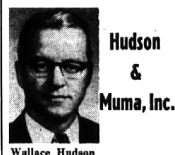
## stop shouting!

## It's 'Schuss' In 6 More Areas Here

Michigan skiers will have six more areas at their ski-tips this season.

Two new areas will open in the upper peninsula: Indian Head Mountain near Ironwood in the western end of the peninsula, and Mission Hill resort, 23 miles west of Sault Ste. Marie in the eastern end.

THE WESTERN lower peninsula, meanwhile, will have four new areas—Jordan Valley lodge near East Jordan, Goshorn Hills near Saugatuck, Hu-Lu Heights near Hudsonville, and Indian Hills at Grand Rapids.

Goshorn Hills, Hu-Lu Heights and Indian Hills are tobogganing centers, and the first two also offer large skating rinks. The new Jordan Valley area is scheduled to open with 12 ski runs up to 5,000 feet in length.

The Ludington Ski area, nine miles southeast of Ludington, opened last season and will be starting its first full year of operation with six runs.

IMPROVEMENTS at other areas throughout the state include: Boyne Mountain (at Boyne Falls) — new two-story alpine lodge, doubling accommodations capacity; expansion of double-chair lift facilities; expanded main dining room; and installation of auto-

matic waxing machine. Obersee (near Cadillac) — new T-bar lift; increase in ski runs to 31; and erection of warming house for tournament judges.

NUB'S NOB (near Harbor Springs) — completion of two-story alpine lodge to accommodate 100 persons; increase to nine ski runs. Walloon Hills (near Walloon Lake) — new T-bar lift with capacity of 1,000 skiers per hour; expansion of clubhouse.

Holiday Hills (near Traverse City) — new T-bar lift; wider snow machine coverage.

Mount Mancelona (near Mancelona) — completion of second story on lodge.

Many other areas report improvements in slopes and towls, additional lights for night skiing.

WITH USAF TASK FORCE, Australia and New Zealand—Among the 180 officers and air-crew members of the U.S. Air Force, participating in a friend task force of aircraft visiting the "down under" countries of Australia and New Zealand is Major Thomas T. Sobieski, 36, of Troy.

The goodwill task force, made up mostly of Fifth Air Force personnel and aircraft, formed at Clark Air Force base in the Philippines and departed there on Oct. 12.

the Queensland area Centenary celebration, and at the opening ceremonies of the Wellington International airport in New Zealand.

Major Sobieski is a member of the 317th Troop Carrier squadron, 315th Air division, Pacific air force, and his assignment on this goodwill mission is that of transport mission commander. He is the son of Mr. Angela W. Sobieski, 2800 Crooks road, Troy.
