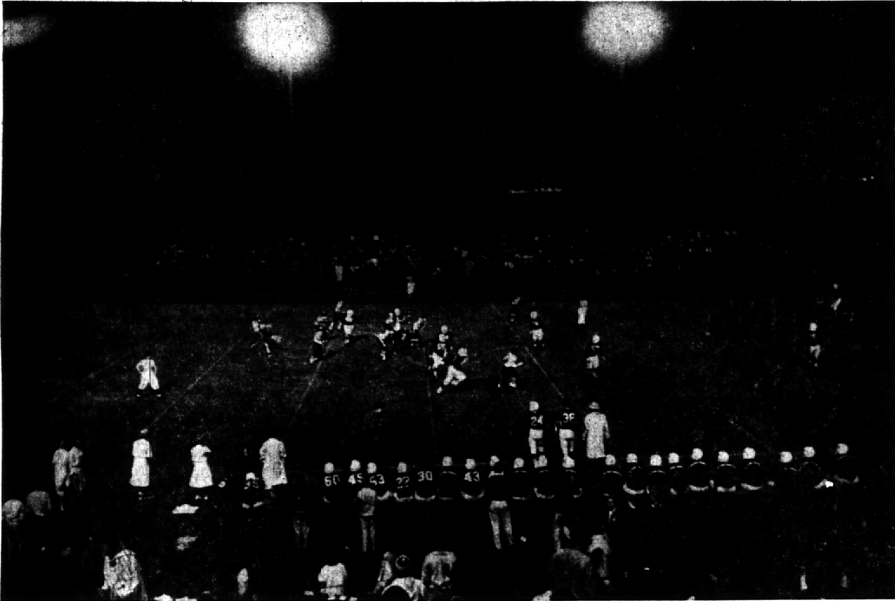

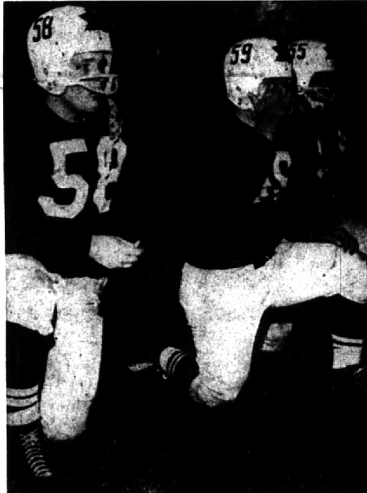
watch football make its grand entrance. Seaholm won, 26-0, to the delight of the Maple fans. There's no doubt about it . . . football has returned.
