E. S. Matheson, general manager of Auto Club, and his wife, accompanied the group.

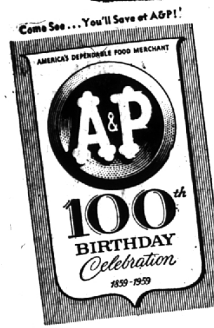
Kingswood Exhibits Photos By Croze
