## Swimming Club Seeks to Buy City Property

Birmingham officials are reviewing the request of Forest Hills Swim Club, Inc. to purchase city-owned property for a swimming pool site as a nursery.

The request was made by club President Leslie W. Fleming, who said the private group wants to purchase the city's triangular parcel between Manor road and the Grand Trunk Western railroad north of ten lots on Shephardsh. The city forestry department uses the site as a nursery.

Birmingham city commissioners have asked City Manager L. R. Carr and City Planner Herbert Herzberg to study and report on the request.

GARE TOLD commissioners he had received several calls from nearby residents protesting the location of a swimming pool at the northeast Birmingham site.

"Regardless of what we do here," he stated, "we must face the fact we will have to deal with similar future requests."

The swim club, which expects to have a membership of 350 families, hopes to build an Olympic-sized pool, wading pool, bathroom and parking area by next summer.

Plans and estimates have been prepared and are on file with the Township Board of Public Examination. The estimated cost as prepared shows the cost of building would be \$24,000.
