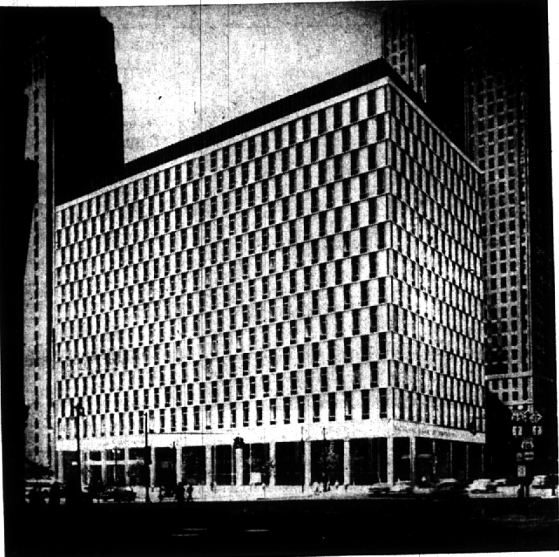

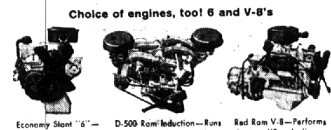

WHAT DOCTORS SAY ABOUT

Recovery from Schizophrenia Possible

● Rheumatic Fever
● Tongue-Tie

Q. Does anyone ever recover from schizophrenia?
A. Very generally, about one-third of patients with schizophrenia treated during the first year of illness make a very good recovery, one-third get a little better and are able to return to outside life, and one-third have to remain in the hospital indefinitely. A great deal depends on how soon treatment is started, the personality of the patient, and other factors.

Q. Would you please let me know through Medical Mirror what causes rheumatic fever? Is it inherited?—A.A.

A. Rheumatic fever is almost always preceded by a nose or throat infection caused by a special type of strep germ. Seemingly, the infection must be present for about three weeks before rheumatic symptoms develop. Treatment during this time can ward off rheumatic fever. The disease itself is not inherited but certain

family groups seem especially prone to development of rheumatic fever. This suggests some inbred tendency or weakness but just how important this remains unproved.

Q. My two-year-old is tongue-tied. Would snipping the fold of skin under the tongue help? He hasn't yet started to talk.

A. Many people believe that if a child is slow in acquiring speech, he must be "tongue-tied." It may seem logical to snip the frenulum or fold of skin under the tongue. However, severing the frenulum without anesthesia is barbarous to say the least. A light or short frenulum does not prevent a child from acquiring speech at the normal age although it may cause a minor lip. Do two things: put the scissors back in the sewing basket and have the child examined by a physician.

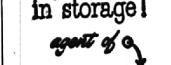
Part of the east half of the southeast quarter of section 32, town 3 north, range 19 east, Southfield Township, Oakland County, Michigan, described as follows: Commencing at the southeast corner of said Section 32; thence north 87 degrees 45 minutes 21 seconds west along the south line of said Section 32, a distance of 624.6 feet; thence north 2 degrees 18 minutes 39 seconds east, a distance of 104.2 feet to a point in the north right-of-way line of East Mile Road; thence north 87 degrees 45 minutes 15 seconds west along the north right-of-way line of East Mile Road, a distance of 67 feet; thence north 87 degrees 45 minutes 44 seconds east, a distance of 492.19 feet; thence south 87 degrees 45 minutes 8 seconds east, a distance of 210.14 feet; thence south 8 degrees 55 minutes 29 seconds west, a distance of 333.0 feet to a point in the northerly boundary of the land conveyed to Greater C. Higgins, State Highway Commissioner for the State of Michigan by Warranty Deed, recorded June 4, 1959, in Liber 779 of Deeds, page 627; thence south 23 degrees 17 minutes 4 seconds west, along said northerly boundary line, a distance of 116.92 feet to the point of beginning.
