Twice the Safety On Our Turnpikes

Turnpikes were almost twice as safe in 1958 as other roads and highways, according to the national safety council.

The council, in its recently published statistical yearbook, reports that the number of deaths per 100 million passenger miles was 1.3 on the turnpikes, 2.3 on other highways and roads.

A total of 270 deaths to auto passengers and drivers occurred on turnpikes in 1958. More than 24,000 such deaths occurred in
