TUESDAY EVENING, the 54-foot march at the foot of Woodward Avenue in Detroit will be lighted by ten-year-old Paula Parsons, a cured former cancer patient. The lighting will be accompanied by an hour-long television show broadcast on all four local channels.

Steve Allen, network television star, will act as master of ceremonies, heading a cast which will include many outstanding television personalities.

Among them will be Mimi Benzell, Smiling Jack Smith, the Honey Dreamers, and Jonah Jones.

VOLUNTEERS attending the kickoff luncheon, to be held at noon Tuesday, will bear Hertsell Wilson, assistant sales promotion manager for Plymouth, and will see "Miss America."

On Oct. 20, the first report luncheon will be held, at which progress of the campaign to that date will be revealed. Similar reports will be made at luncheons to be held Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays until November 5.

Arrangements are being made to have outstanding leaders from widely varied backgrounds address luncheons, each of which is sponsored by corporations which have fulfilled their obligations to their community by fair share contributions to the Torch Drive.

During the 10 previous Torch Drives, \$137,000,000 has been made available for local, state and national health and community services. The goal set this year, \$17,500,000, is the largest ever sought by any one community.
