## Summer Recreation Program Draws Record Crowds Here

The entire program of summer activities was well received by the citizenry of Birmingham as proven by the attendance figures.

The playgrounds were held at Adams Park, Pembroke, Elton Park, Quanton and Midvale with 1,000 more children attending than last year, this year's totaling 11,157. The children were exposed to a variety of leisure time activities to stimulate their initiative and interest and creativity.

Arts, crafts, music, singing, storytelling, sports and nature lore gave a well-rounded program to the youngsters. The new nature and woodcraft program at the day camp captured the interest of many youngsters.

THE SUMMER swimming activities were extremely well-attended featuring family and teen swimming and swim lessons for elementary school age children, an over all count shows 24,200 participations in the summer swimming program, 1959.

The golf program for boys and girls nine through 16 years held at Springdale showed an upward swing in attendance with as many as 90 golfers participating in one day's activities.

The music program held at the Seaholm high school enrolled 191 youngsters for the eight-week session. Interest in riflery was high as the youngsters attended the police rifle range for the six week program, attendance averaged 30 youngsters per day.

THE TENNIS instruction gained the attention of more teenagers and adults with the two evening sessions of lessons. The annual tennis tournament co-sponsored by The Eccentric and the Recreation department stimulated the tennis enthusiasts. The department records show 2,400 participations for the eight weeks.

ARCHERY enthusiasm was heightened with 25 to 30 archers taking part daily in the events, also adding excitement was the Archery tournament.

The new program, baton twirling, attracted many little ladies, approximately 50 per day, for the six week session. The physical fitness program held on the playgrounds provided the playgrounders with the chance to participate in a city-wide field day. Winners were awarded prizes.

### Name Observatory For Late Trustee, Henry S. Hulbert

CRANBROOK — At a recent meeting of the board of trustees, Cranbrook institute of science, the Cranbrook observatory was named the Henry Schoolcraft Hulbert Observatory as a memorial to the man "who worked for the institute and the greater community with such devotion and intelligence."

The reference is to the late Judge Henry S. Hulbert, a trustee of Cranbrook Institute from 1930 to his death in the spring of 1959. October dates for use of the observatory telescope are October 6 and 13 for members, October 8 and 16 for non-members.

SINCE SPACE and time are limited, appointments for use of the telescope must be made ahead by telephoning the institute during office hours Monday through Friday. "We can guarantee," states the Institute's October Newsletter, "that you cannot see the hammer and sickle reportedly planted on the moon in September, but the 6-inch refractor telescope in the observatory will give you a starting close-up of the Sea of Tranquility as well as other "seas" and ridges on the moon's surface. "You can also get a high-powered look at Saturn and at star clusters, double stars and nebulae. If skies are overcast, appointments are cancelled."
