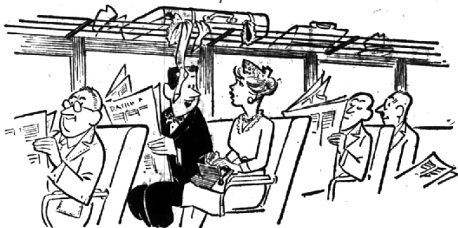

In Oakland County ... County Planners Report Future Growth Prospects

Most of Oakland county's residents live in the nine southeastern townships, according to a report issued recently by the Oakland county planning commission. The county could end up with a population of over 5 million, if other areas develop as thickly as Royal Oak township. However, the plan commission gave several reasons why it believes the county's population will never reach the 5 million mark.

The report said 87 per cent of county population of 660,000 is centered in the southeast townships, with the remainder scattered throughout the 16 northern and western townships.

Further development can be expected in the north and west with the completion of the Walter P. Chrysler expressway and the extension of Northwestern highway. The Michigan State University Oakland establishment has already stimulated increased building and subdivision interest in that area.

THE COUNTY'S most densely populated area is Royal Oak township, where 240,000 people live. The density rate is 6,513 persons per square mile.

If the Royal Oak township density rate applied eventually to the rest of the county, its population would exceed 5 1/2 million.

However, the report said, "it is not likely that the county population will ever reach such an astronomical figure because the revised zoning ordinances of many communities require greater lot areas per dwelling unit, soil conditions in many areas discourage use of septic tanks, the lowering water table is making individual wells increasingly impractical, and there is an increasing number of large land areas being reserved for recreational, industrial and educational uses."

MICHIGAN'S department of conservation owns about 21,000 acres of land in the northern and western parts of the county, and proposes to acquire more. The Huron Clinton Metropolitan authority controls another 6,000 acres in the county's 877 square miles.

"It is very improbable that any of this property will ever be made available for residential purposes," the report said. "These factors will reduce population density in areas which are not now developed."

Oakland county, the report points out, is located at the midpoint of an emerging "interurbia" of adjacent communities which will stretch from Toledo to the Saginaw-Ray City-Midland

GOP Build-Up Set for Oakland By Party Heads

With the start of a new Council of Women's clubs last week, Oakland county Republicans led into a new organizational program, expected to be announced officially later in the fall.

Behind the stepped-up organizational drive is county Republican apprehension expressed recently by the party's executive secretary, Jack A. Gibbs.

"This isn't a safe county for us any more. We can't merely rely on a handful of people who will make telephone calls," Gibbs said. Aiming at the 1960 election, county GOP executives are expected to worm an honorary committee of about 600.

Formation of the new Council of Women's clubs drew protests from the 27-year-old Federation of Republican Women.

Unemployment Down

One of the lowest weekly unemployment figures in three years was recorded last week by the Royal Oak Michigan Employment security commission office. It showed that unemployment in South Oakland county dropped from 2,357 persons two weeks previously to 2,124.

Ford was main speaker of the evening, praising Broomfield for his program of economy in government. Congressman Robert P. Griffin, formerly of Pontiac, also spoke.

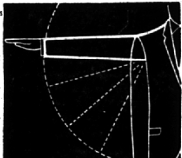
