The bridesmaids wore Copenhagen blue silk organza dresses with scoop necklines and full skirts and carried miniature gladioli.

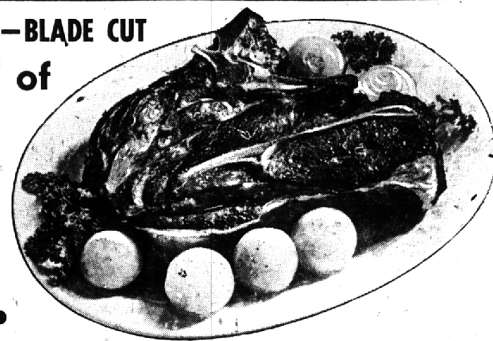
The bride's mother wore a street length blue peau de soie sheath. The groom's mother was dressed in slate gray silk sheath. Both mothers had orchid corsages.

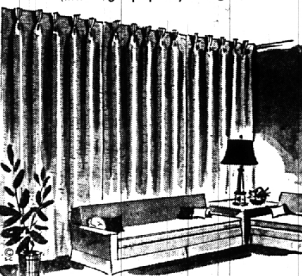
