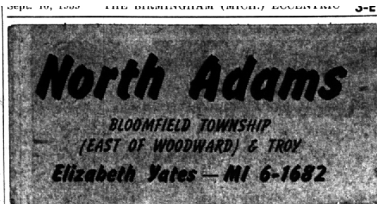
The club was organized in December, 1958 by Mrs. Clemons, an active Democratic party member for seven years.

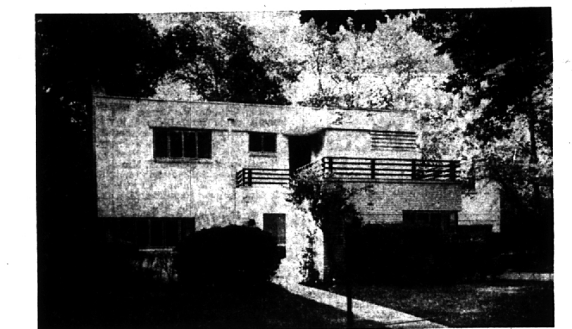
