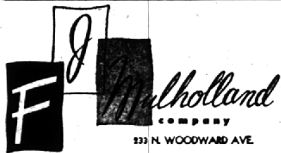

For nine years, he owned and operated his own car dealership in Birmingham and entered the real estate business in 1954. He was a charter member of the local Birmingham Kiwanis club.

FLACK was born in New York and graduated from the Collegiate Prep School there which is the oldest educational institutional in the country.

After this, he took special courses in history at Harvard and the University of Virginia. His business background includes banking, public utilities, life insurance and extensive selling background with other concerns. He entered the real estate business several years ago and has established a distinguished record in this field.

Flack's military record in World War II was that of Commanding Officer of a Military Government unit in New Guinea, the Philippines and Korea from 1942 thru 1946. He is presently a Lt. Colonel in the U. S. Army reserves.

He has been a member of the Birmingham Real Estate board of

directors for two years, was formerly chairman of the Red Cross speakers bureau in New York and has been a national director of the U. S. junior chamber of commerce. He is one of the founding members of the Birmingham Congregational church. He is noted as a speaker and writer on historical subjects, particularly with reference to the American Civil War period.

Kinney, in expanding his corporate organization, spent considerable time evaluating and selecting these three extremely capable men in order to better serve the public.

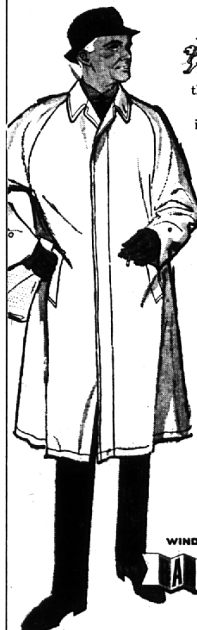
