## Chrysler's 1960 Preview at Miami Beach This Week

MIAMI BEACH—The first of more than 400 newsmen from every section of the nation began arriving here yesterday morning to preview Chrysler Corporation's 1960 passenger cars and trucks.  
 Included in the guest list are 133 newsmen from television and radio stations, and representatives from all major television networks. Motion picture and newspaper organizations servicing the theatrical newsreel and syndicated television news services are also represented.  
 Chrysler Corporation has taken over the entire Americana Hotel to house the visitors and more than 100 of its executives.

**LAST NIGHT** newsmen were guests at a reception and on Thursday a fast-moving two-day program will open with an official welcome and address by Chrysler Corporation President L. L. Colbert of Bloomfield Hills.  
 Preparations for the preview have been under way for months, since transporting men, materials and vehicles from Detroit to Miami—a distance of 1,500 miles—present a logistics project of substantial proportions.  
 A total of 103 new passenger car models have been shipped to Miami Beach for the gala preview. Twenty-eight of the cars will be featured in a 45-minute stage extravaganza Thursday afternoon when the company's 1960 cars are officially presented to the nation's press.  
 Others will be available outdoors for riding and driving in restricted areas. In addition, 30 of the company's new 1960 commercial vehicles have been assembled for a special truck introductory show on Friday.

**THE THURSDAY** afternoon new car show will have a cast of 60 people as well as a 29-piece orchestra.  
 Although the newspaper, magazine, TV and radio representatives

will see, ride and drive the new cars, no photos of the models will be released for publication until next month.

## Five Safety Facts As Schools Resume

Consider, as back-to-school time arrives, these five facts from the National Safety Council:  
 1. Accidents are the leading cause of death to school-age children.  
 2. More than 2,500 children 5-14 years of age are killed annually in accidents involving motor vehicles.  
 3. More than 1,100 of those children are pedestrians.  
 4. A total of 150,000 children in the 5-14 age group are injured each year in motor vehicle mishaps.  
 5. One out of 12 students injured in a "school-jurisdiction" accident is on his way to or from school.

**THAT'S THE problem**—and back-to-school time is when the problem reaches its peak, according to the National Safety Council. Solution to the problem?  
 "Parents," the Council said, "should teach their children to stop, look and listen before crossing streets or railroad tracks. It's not old-fashioned to be safe."  
 "Parents also should set a proper example. Don't expect a child to obey a rule you violate."

**SOME COUNCIL** suggestions to motorists as the nation's schools prepare to open their doors:  
 1. Keep your car in good condition. Pay special attention to tires and brakes. You can't blame the garage man if your car doesn't stop quickly enough in an emergency.  
 2. Drive slowly near schools. And slow down where children are walking or playing.  
 3. Expect the unexpected from children. Most of them get hurt running from behind parked cars or crossing in the middle of an intersection.
