

Decries Clinics' Slash by County

OAKLAND COUNTY—"We actually need twice as many guidance services as are currently offered," said Oakland county Probate Judge Arthur E. Moore recently. The judge decried the pending decision to cut the Oakland county

clinics in 1944. "Under the charter the state pays the salaries of all skilled employees—psychiatrists and social workers," the judge explained. "Money for secretarial help and office supplies comes from the county."

County Drops Guidance Clinics From '60 Budget

A 1960 Oakland county budget due for passage this week calls for eliminating the \$35,000 appropriation to the Oakland child guidance clinic. It also gives a pay raise to almost all county employees. The final budget figure for 1960 is expected to be about \$12,750,000. The tax rate would be \$5.82 per \$1,000. The pay raise will cost the county about \$225,000 more, the salary budget reaching \$5,432,751. Last week the board of supervisors' ways and means committee, in making out the budget voted 5 to 2 not to give the child guidance clinic any county funds next year.

ELIMINATION of county assistance would seriously hamper the operation of the Birmingham branch of the child guidance clinic. Already the clinic's newly-referred cases must wait six months before treatment can be started by its small staff.

Supporters of the guidance clinic were told last week by Supervisor Fred W. Smith that "the county's \$2,037,000 building fund was 'irrevocably' committed to a new court house."

Arguing that psychiatric treatment of disturbed children deserves a high priority, Noel Buckner, of Bloomfield Hills, told the ways and means committee, "There's more to life than brick and mortar."

THE COMMITTEE told guidance clinic supporters that no money was available for the allocation to the clinics. Officials say clinic branches may have to be shut, and that matching state funds might be terminated.

Royal Oak Man Heads Red Cross Regional Drive

The appointment of Adolph F. Klein, of Royal Oak, as regional chairman for the American Red Cross' 1960 fund drive was announced this week. 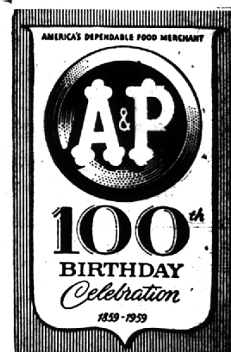
