State Vetoes B'ham Policy

The State of Michigan tapped the City of Birmingham on the shoulder this week and informed it that the method it has been using to insure city property, though a good one, is illegal.

Birmingham, said City Manager L. E. Gary, has purchased its insurance from local agents through one central agent.

"It's a good system, too," Gary told city commissioners at this week's meeting.

He presented the commission with letters from the Michigan

Municipal League and state department of Insurance, which pointed out the illegality of the practice. Gary will have to attend a meeting April 18 in Lansing to learn why the practice is outlawed.

Oak Ridge Institute Gives Local Fellow AEC Fellowship

Douglas N. Reinhard, 377 Kimberly, Birmingham, has been selected to receive an Atomic Energy commission Special Fellowship in Nuclear Science and Engineering.

Reinhard, who has been studying at the University of Michigan, is one of 231 outstanding young students from thirty-nine states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico, who have been appointed to receive these fellowships.

Administered for the AEC by the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies, the fellowships are designed to aid and encourage promising students who are studying for master's or doctor's degrees in nuclear fields.

Fellowship appointments are made for twelve months, and may be used for study at one of 45 designated universities throughout the country.

Swim Club Set To View Final Plans for Pool

With architect's plans for their pool near Eton park to be completed within the week, Forest Hills swim club members, guests and friends will meet in the auditorium of the Birmingham Community House Tuesday at 8 p.m.

Club President Leslie Fleming, a Birmingham attorney, will discuss with the audience the drawings by

architects Wheeler, Becker and Sando, and will answer questions about the pool.

Fleming said bids from contractors would be in by April 18. Contracts will then be let, with actual construction beginning about May 1. Adequate safeguards have been incorporated to insure soundness of the pool's financing, Fleming added.

The first jointly-owned private pool in Birmingham, it will be 82 feet long, 42 feet wide, with a 40 by 25 foot of for three diving boards.

The club plans a children's wading pool, bath house, sun deck and substantial lawn area, along with parking for more than 165 cars.
