During the eight-day session,

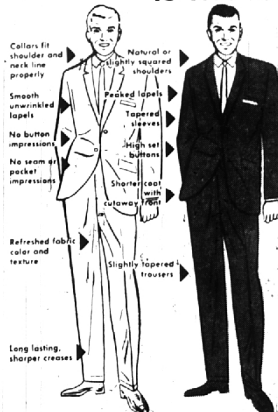
the youths "learn by doing" the mechanics and operation of city, county and state government.

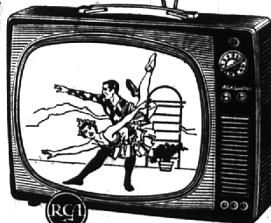

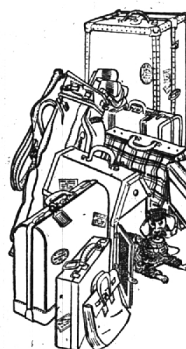
