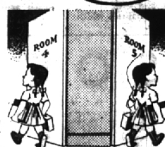

Medical Mirror
WHAT DOCTORS SAY ABOUT**Separation
of Twins**

- Pinworm Carriers
- Feeble-Minded Offspring



Q: Is it advisable to put twins in different classrooms on starting school?

A: It is generally advisable to gradually bring about some separation between twins. If they are together all the time and dealt with as though they were one person, they tend to lean exclusively on each other. It is also easier for each other. If they are not together all the time, separate classrooms, when feasible, would seem best.

Q: Is it possible for a person to become infected with pinworms through contact with a dog?

A: The veterinarian said dogs are not carriers of pinworms.

Q: There are many causes of mental deficiency. To give a satisfactory answer to this question it would be necessary to know the cause in this case. However, it is not unlikely that, since the baby had at least one feeble-minded parent, the chances are much greater than average that the child also will be mentally below par.
