Official Predicts
Need for Writers

CHICAGO—Technical publications are as essential as missile nose cones in the Space Age, and if the amount of technical information required continues its current rate of increase an estimated 65,000 writers will be needed in commercial, industrial, institutional, government and military establishments to process and interpret it by 1970!

These were some of the salient facts presented by Chrysler corporation missile division officials at the national convention of the Society of technical writers and editors here April 21.
F. M. Van Sickle, 983 Wimbledon, manager of the publications branch of Chrysler corporation's missile division and a panel moderator at the convention, said that society is faced with an "information explosion" as the result of vast increases in research and development expenditures.

The number of technical journals increased from 1,500 in 1920 to 4,700 in 1952 and will probably reach 6,000 in 1970, Van Sickle said.
The number of articles published in technical journals, he added, will probably increase from 650,000 to 1,200,000 annually by 1970.


