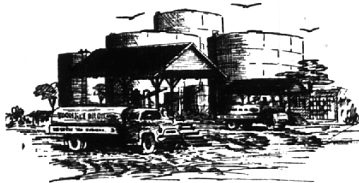

Cranbrook Academy Names Two to Faculty

Zoltan Sepeshy, president of Cranbrook Academy of Art, has announced the appointment of two new faculty members. Laurence A. Barker will head the new department of graphics which, until this fall, has been a minor subject. The addition of graphics brings the number of academy departments up to eight: painting, graphics, sculpture, architecture, industrial design, weaving, metalsmithing and ceramics.

Howard O. Brown, who was graduated from Cranbrook Academy with an M.F.A. degree in 1954, replaces Charles Metzger as head of the industrial design department.

AFTER A THREE-YEAR stint with the Army Air Corps, he received his B.E.A. degree from the University of Illinois in art and architecture. Later he received an M.A. degree from Michigan state university.

Brown's teaching experience includes Michigan state university, head of the industrial design and interior design curriculum; Rochester Institute of Technology Art School, head of the three-dimensional design curriculum; visiting professor of design at New York state university college for teachers, and teacher of jewelry and design at the school for American craftsmen.

His work has been exhibited in many shows from Michigan to Pennsylvania, New York to Wisconsin. He is a member of the College Art Association and the American Association of University Professors.

Laurence A. Barker, who also did his stint in the air force, was graduated from Cranbrook academy of art in 1955 with an M.F.A. degree—a year later than Brown.

HE HAD previously received his A.B. at Principia college. After Cranbrook he studied teaching in Paris with S. W. Hayter in studio 17, traveled in England and on the continent, and returned to teach

design, watercolor, drawing and graphics at Miami university, Oxford, O., until the spring of this year.

With his wife Josefa, a native of Argentina, his son Javier and daughter Mercedes, Barker is living in Birmingham at 493 Frank St.

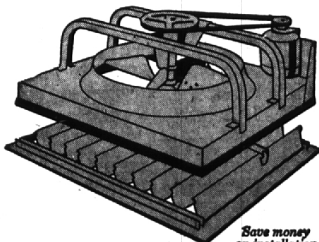

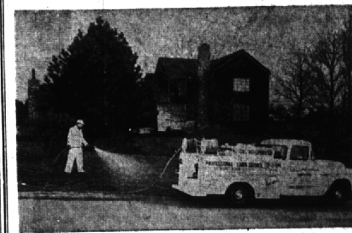
