## Troy News Briefs

### Clips Pole, Clips Pole, Tree, Houses

**TROY**—A car which police said was traveling 90 to 100 mph went out of control and struck a utility pole, two trees and two houses Friday July 27, seriously injuring the driver.

Bruner, 23, of 30290 Barrington, Troy, was taken to St. Joseph Mercy hospital.

Bruner was traveling north on John R. when his car left the road near Chancery, a half-mile south of Twenty Mile road, careened 143 ft. off the highway and bounced from pole to tree to houses and rolled 39 ft.

**THE CAR** WAS demolished while the houses were only slightly damaged, police said.

One owned by Albert D. Jackson, 6753 John R., had windows broken. The other, owned by Ronnie Resler, 4745 John R., received a damaged front wall.

### OK Street Paving For 2 Subdivisions

**TROY**—Asphalt paving for more than a mile of streets in the Belzair and Bolzair No. 1 subdivisions at an estimated cost of \$22,951 has been approved by Troy city commissioners.

Special assessments on abutting property owners will supply funds, including the city's 5 per cent share.

A public hearing on the assessments will be held at 7:30 p.m. Aug. 8 at the city hall.

### Seek to Aid Fire Victims

**TROY**—Neighbors are taking up a collection to buy clothing and basic home furnishings for a family of eight left homeless by a fire which swept the rear of their home July 23.

The owner, Mrs. Tilden Sutherland, said the home itself was insured but that furnishings and clothing, which were almost totally destroyed by fire, smoke and water, were not.

A public hearing on the assessments will be held at 7:30 p.m. Aug. 8 at the city hall.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT** officials said the blaze, confined mostly to the children's bedroom and kitchen, took 45 minutes to extinguish.

The Sutherlands and their six children—aged 3 years to 10—are staying with relatives at 1770 Larchwood, Troy. Donations may be sent there or to Mrs. Muriel Hawthorne, 1814 Birchwood, Troy, who is heading the fund drive.

### Ride Leads To Drowning

A pleasure ride in a motorboat led to the drowning of a Troy man and a narrow escape for his mother-in-law at Bald Eagle lake near Ortonville July 24.

Richard Foto, 40, of 3363 Rochester road, tangled in an anchor rope which held him under water after his boat capsized.

His mother-in-law, Mrs. Leila Hauger, 65, was thrown clear of the boat and managed to hang onto its side until she was rescued by Foto's brother-in-law, Angelo DeSantis, 461 E. Sixteen Mile, who saw the capsizing from shore and raced to her aid in his own boat.

DeSantis ALSO recovered Foto's body.

A pipefitter for Waterway Construction Co., Foto survived by his wife, Anna, 37, and their children: Mary Louise, 18; Anthony, 17; Phyllis Ann, 12, and Rosemary, 8.

### Let Sewer Contract To Connect 2 Areas To Evergreen Line

**TROY**—A contract for extension of sanitary sewers into two subdivisions at a cost of \$69,682 has been awarded by the city to the Motor City Excavating Co. of East Detroit.

The extension will tie the Leonard Lane and Supervisor's Plat 27 subdivisions in the area between Sixteen Mile and Seventeen Mile roads west of Adams to the Evergreen sanitary interceptor.

The low bid among the three submitted came from the Oak Park Excavating Co. but was rejected on the recommendation of City Manager David Hasse who said that part of the bid came in after the submission deadline.

### Lack of Fatalities Brings City Award

**TROY**—An award for no pedestrian fatalities in the city during 1959 placed Troy among only 18 cities in the nation so honored.

The award was presented to Police Chief David E. Gruttop, Mayor Pro-Tem Clifford F. Suttmeister, Jr., and City Manager David W. Hasse by officials of the Birmingham branch of the Auto club on behalf of the American Auto Assn. and the Michigan Auto club.
